

## HARPER NOT HERE FOR TAXPAYERS

### \$5.3 Billion lost by Harper

Conservative Senator Hugh Segal is the Chair of the Special Senate Committee on Anti-Terrorism. On March 22, 2011 the Senate was speaking about Mr. Segal's call to investigate the illegal tobacco trade which under Prime Minister Harper has increased dramatically. Since Mr. Harper became Prime Minister Canadian Taxpayers have lost \$5.3 billion to organized crime which Harper refuses to deal with.

Senator Banks stated, "Senator Segal has raised a problem that he described as now worse than ever, and it has to do with the law... The amounts are in the billions — not millions, but billions — it is also about the flagrancy of illegal activity by everyone involved: by criminal gangs; by ordinary Canadians out to make a fast, easy and relatively safe buck because no one prosecutes them; and by members of First Nations... However, nowhere in the treaty does it say that anyone is entitled to conduct criminal activity. Nowhere in the treaty does it say that there is a licence to break the laws. Nowhere does it permit tobacco smuggling, drug smuggling and people smuggling by Aboriginal people or by anyone else... These things are all taking place... No self-respecting nation whose first responsibility is to the safety and security of its citizens can stand idly by, watching while criminals operate openly and with impunity."

### \$5.3 Billion could have been used by Harper for:

Improving Health Care - Tax Rebates for Families  
Job Creation Program - Reduced University Costs

Instead the Harper Government has stood by and watched the safety and security of its citizens be compromised. If you or I openly committed criminal acts that cost taxpayers billions we would be arrested immediately. However, under Harper's leadership racist policing policies have been allowed to flourish.

### \$7.5 Billion in lost Economic Activity in Ontario

In 2008 the government heard a report of how \$7.5 billion had been lost due to illegal activities throughout Ontario by a few dozen Native protesters. The Canadian Military listed the Mohawk Warriors Society as a violent insurgency group. However, the Harper government had the military issue an apology to the Mohawk Warriors in Dec. 2010.

## HARPER NOT HERE FOR POLICE OFFICERS

On Dec. 1, 2007 several OPP officers were assaulted by Clyde Powless who also assaulted Gary McHale. Six days later the OPP Investigation determined that Powless would face a criminal charge for assaulting McHale, mischief for pulling a hydro tower across the road and a charge of assaulting an OPP Officer. However, Mr. Fantino ordered the investigators not to charge Powless with assaulting a police officer. Under oath in court Mr. Fantino couldn't provide any reason why he gave such an order. Mr. Fantino even wrote a letter of reference to be used in court in support of Powless.

Christie Blatchford: "It was extraordinary, and it was now official: Ontario's senior law officer [Fantino] and the head of the 2nd biggest police force in Canada was not only privately targeting and publicly denouncing the victim of an assault, he was also telling a judge it was the victim's fault and singing the praises of the assailant."

In 2009 a Superior Court Judge ordered Mr. Powless to face a criminal charge of assaulting a Police Officer, obstructing a Police Officer and being a member of a riot. OPP Officer Jeff Bird testified that during this riot his "greatest concern was Clyde Powless yelling out, 'Get their gun belts, you cops are ours.'"



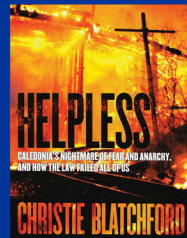
Six months after the riot and after several OPP officers were assaulted Fantino is seen in this photograph laughing it up with Clyde Powless.

## Elections Canada charges 4 senior Conservatives

In Feb. 2011 Elections Canada charged Conservative Senator Doug Finley, Conservative Senator Irving Garstein, Michael Donison and Susan J. Kehoe with violating Election Laws. The Conservative Fund of Canada & the Conservative Party of Canada have also been charged. The Conservative Fund of Canada faces an additional charge of filing a false statement.

## Fantino targets Elected Officials and threatens them

In 2007 democratically elected Councillor Craig Grice of Haldimand County sent an email responding to a question from a person in his riding. Mr. Fantino became enraged that Councillor Grice failed to condemn people who were attempting to raise Canadian Flags in Caledonia. Under Fantino's leadership it had become illegal to raise the Canadian Flag in Caledonia but legal to place dozens of Mohawk Warrior Flags throughout the town.

## Fantino faced a Criminal Charge

In 2009 Superior Court Judge Crane ordered Mr. Fantino to face the criminal charge of Attempting to Influence Municipal Officials because he threatened Haldimand Council when they spoke out about local issues. Prime Minister Harper handpicked Julian Fantino even after Fantino was charge for threatening elected officials.

## Statement by Gary McHale regarding Fantino

Mr. Fantino has repeatedly demonstrated that if you speak out for your community then he will use the full resources of the state to silence you. He will actively create a smear campaign against you. He will target you for arrest and order his officers to overlook 'legal nuances' in order to get you. In his eyes you become an enemy of the state even though you have broken no laws.

## Feds give \$1.2 million: Used to promote Terrorism

The Federal Department of Canadian Heritage has provided a total of \$1.2 Million in funding to RedWire Magazine (Native Youth Magazine), and continues to fund it despite knowing that its 2007 Defending the Land edition contained a 'how-to' guide entitled 'War Against the Machines' to instruct would-be terrorists on how to block roads, attack snowmobilers, cause floods, use Molotov cocktails and destroy bridges, machinery and hydro lines.

In 2007 Sam Gaultier, photo above, was building a home for his daughter when the sub-division was occupied by thugs. For one month repeated cries for help to the OPP, when Fantino was Commissioner, went unanswered due to OPP policies.

In Sept. 2007 these thugs entered Mr. Gaultier's home and when he told them to leave he was attacked and beaten almost to death - he currently suffers brain damage which has caused his construction business to go bankrupt.

Under Fantino's leadership family run business owners like Mike Corrado and Dave Eccles were targeted by the OPP for arrest instead of arresting those who openly attempted to extort money from these family businesses.

Superior Court Judge D. Ramsay disagreed with Fantino and the OPP policies and ruled the policies were illegal.
